We have had a very busy summer this year with many teams visiting from Scotland, Leicester, 2 teams from Bristol, Sweden & Norway. Thank you so much to those who came and for your time spent with the children from the Old City (Casino area).

Recently Mihaela and I took 10 children to the Project Romania Rescue Camp at Kogalniceanu for 5 days of camping, fun, games and biblical teaching. The staff of Project Romania Rescue were helped by Alan & Janet Kirkpatrick and Ron from my home Church United Life, Sutton, Surrey and a team from Capital Christian Centre, Bismarck, North Dakota, the latter provided all the food, crafts and all the costs involved with the camp to make it possible for 50 children to attend at no cost to the families and organizations attending. The children also received clothing, boys T shirts and girls one piece T Shirts and shorts from World Vision.

For Denisa, who is 16, this was the first time she had been away from home. Home is one room which is shared by ten people, her mother, aunts and uncles and cousins. She has not been to school for two years as the family had no money for uniform or school equipment. She spends her time begging for food. She enjoys coming to the Kids Club and she is so helpful with

younger kids. The camp has quite an effect on her as she now shares her prayers with us.

Those of you who have visited the Kids Club will remember Max who leads the Club. He has been a volunteer with us for 4 years. He is now 21 and is at University studying Engineering & Electronics. We would like to be able to support him financially, covering his travel expenses and some of his living expenses. He is totally committed to the children and they in turn love and respect him. This month he will be leading a new club for the teenagers on Saturdays.

We are still praying for a Homework Club where the children can come and have space to do their school work and get some extra help. Some of the children are already falling behind with their studies as it is very difficult to work at home and their parent/parents do not read or write. Our prayer is for a volunteer to come and lead this work.
